This glass panel is a composite of fields of poppies, borage, rape and ploughed fields that make up the Buckinghamshire countryside with the Chiltern woods behind. Christine's work gives a kaleidoscopic impression of Yousden Wood which is an untouched wild place where wild orchids grow in the meadows and flint Stone Age tools can be found at the base of the old beech trees.
