Adams Wood is home to badgers, muntjac, deer, fox, rabbits, squirrels, buzzards, red kite and jays. Artist June Kingsbury says, "During the course of a year I documented and collected a number of objects including feathers, skulls, bones and other animal remains. The squirrel has been cast in glass. All of the bones are in place. A glass bottle form has been blown and is attached to the antler. The open ended blown form contains the wing of a jay. The muntjac skull is as found."
