The Chilterns Outstanding People Award

Rewarding individuals or groups that have made an outstanding contribution to the conservation of the Chilterns AONB or to raising awareness of it

Who can enter?

Anyone can put someone else forward for the award, as long as the nominee is aware of and agrees to their nomination.

The award is open to groups or individuals.

Nominees may be volunteers or professionals.

What type of nominations will be considered?

Winners of this award could be anyone who has worked towards improving the conservation value or raising awareness of the Chilterns AONB. These could include:

- Conservation volunteers who have improved Chilterns habitats
- Project officers who have led innovative projects
- Community group leaders who have inspired others to get involved
- Individuals or groups who have campaigned on or raised awareness of Chilterns issues.

Closing date for entries:

31st July annually.

Benefits of entering:

The winner will receive a trophy to be held for one year and runners up will receive certificates at the Chilterns Conservation Board's Annual Forum in November.

Winners will receive press coverage locally and in the Chilterns Conservation Board's newsletter.
